IDOT 625 ILCS 5/11– 1502 and 1505- - Traffic Laws apply to persons riding bicycles and Riding Bicycles on the Roadway

- Traffic laws apply to persons riding bicycles. Every person riding a bicycle upon a highway shall be granted all of the rights and shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle.
- Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway shall not ride more than 2 abreast. Persons riding 2 abreast shall not impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic and, on a laned roadway, shall ride within a single lane subject to the provisions of
- USE OF HEADPHONES ARE PROHIBITED BY THE ILLINOIS VEHICLE CODE, AND ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CLUB RIDES.
- AN APPROVED SNELL or ANSI HELMET IS REQUIRED ON ALL RIDES. Failure to wear a helmet results in said ride being no longer designated a Schaumburg Bicycle Club ride. Club members forfeit ride mileage and all other club benefits pertaining to this ride.
